- 4. No tape or glue allowed on walls.
- 5. Exhibitors will be responsible for collecting their own cash and tax.
- 6. Exhibitors must provide their own chairs, tables, table coverings, and change.
- 7. Please proceed to the north-side at the Cafeteria (door #27) to check in when you arrive. After unloading you <u>must move your vehicle(s)</u> to the rear of the school as directed by show staff to allow access for customers.
- 8. Exhibitors are allowed to eat food and beverages in their booth. No smoking at any time in the building. If you require someone to watch your booth for lunch or restroom breaks, please sign up at the check-in desk~we will schedule a volunteer to assist you.
- 9. <u>It is highly suggested that small children not accompany vendors</u> unless they are actively assisting at the booth. We have received complaints from customers and vendors regarding noisy and disruptive children.
